15-16 MAY 2021












The 2021 Victorian Mountain Bike Orienteering Championships will be held in Victoria's Central Goldfields region at Maryborough and Dunolly. There will be three championships contested over the weekend of 15 and 16 May 2021.

The Sprint and Middle Distance events are both within riding distance (<4 km) of central Maryborough. The Long Distance event is in Dunolly, just 24km to the north.

The three event maps were first used for the 2019 Australian MTBO Championships. Copies of these maps will be posted on Eventor for each event.

Note that these events will be subject to Victorian COVID-Safe restrictions that apply at the time. If any entrants are precluded from attending because of COVID restrictions, their entry fees will be refunded.



CLASSES

Age classes offered at each event: M/W 12, 14, 16, 20, 21, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80. e-Bike.

Recreational classes for each course – eg Rec 2 rides Course 2.

COURSE DETAILS

Full course lengths and elevations will be included in the next bulletin.

The table is a guide (in minutes) of what the expected winning times will be for the various age groups.

PUNCHING SYSTEM

We will be using the SPORTident Active Card system (SIAC) – the contactless timing system. We will be using the latest control boxes (BS11) that have a range of 1.5 metres. *These units will only work with a SIAC stick.*

The entry fees include the hire of an SIAC stick for the weekend. If you have your own SIAC stick (number in the range 8000000-8999999), you can claim a \$2 discount (via 'Services') for each event you enter.

All riders need to use a SIAC stick, ie the older SI sticks will not work.

RESULTS

So that competitors can maintain Covid-safe distancing without gathering around a results display, results will not be displayed at the event assembly. Instead, results will be posted up to Eventor progressively throughout the event, and a QR code printed on each map will enable competitors to quickly access the results page on Eventor for each race. So make sure your phone is charged ready to check your results after you've finished.

PRESENTATIONS

Presentations will be made to the first three placegetters in the competition classes. Presentations for the Sprint and Middle Distance Championships will be made as soon as possible after the Middle race on Saturday, and the Long Distance Championships presentation will be made as soon as possible after the race on Sunday.

Terrain: Fast undulating terrain through mainly mixed gum and ironbark open forest. The northern part of the map is used for firewood collection with old rough tracks being progressively overgrown. The track network is forest roads and bush tracks with only a few short single tracks. The most obvious of these tracks have been mapped but progress may be a bit slower in these areas.


ACCOMMODATION
