In addition to traditional bare-rooted trees for winter / spring delivery, the availability of tissue cultured tube stocks has provided the opportunity to now grow trees above ground hydroponically using the ELLEPOT™ system. This means that in the future 'green' trees can be supplied without disturbing roots to allow planting and settling in before dormancy with the aim of reducing replant shock and improving establishment in spring.



Reid Fruits has many global partners and over the next few years expect to offer more exciting new cherry varieties that are currently undergoing testing and will be able to supply a wider range of rootstocks including GiSelA® 3 Gi2091(S), GiSelA® 5 Gi1482(S), GiSelA® 6 Gi1481(S), PIKU 1® and Wavit® Prudom(S)
